WetStone's USLATT is a live acquisition and triage tool using U3 technology that was created under the USB Live Acquisition and Triage Tool (US-LATT) contract funded by the National Institute of Justice (NIJ). This product received an overall five star rating in SC Magazine's group tested technologies. Results are available in the August issue of SC Magazine (www.scmagazine.com)

USLATT provides investigators and first responders with the ability to collect vital live evidence that is lost in pull-the-plug actions. How this technology works is simple. Insert the U3 USB into the suspect system, acquire the most volatile evidence, then remove the token and walk away. All acquisition results are written to the U3 case. USLATT can be configured to collect specific information from the target system(s) and can be operated by users with limited training. This will enable even first responders to collect vital evidence prior to system shutdown. The USLATT is available today in both a LE only version and a commercial product form (LiveU3).
